

Created to help students who have successfully completed the McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Program as undergraduates, this assistantship is open to newly enrolled McNair Scholars in good standing. UF provides a limited number of research assistantships for McNair Scholars who are entering a PhD program in the Fall semester. It provides a base stipend of \$12,000, in-state tuition, fees and health insurance for up to four years.

As part of the program, each student will be appointed as a research assistant and expected to conduct research under a faculty member's supervision. Interested students who meet the eligibility requirements are invited to apply. Since this program is intended to increase enrollment in PhD programs, currently enrolled doctoral students are not eligible.

Deadline: The deadline is April 29, 2020, in anticipation of accepting the fellowship award in Fall 2020. All application materials must be received by the Office of Graduate Diversity Initiatives by the deadline date to be considered.

Support materials that must be attached to your application:

- **Personal statement**
- **An official letter from your undergraduate McNair Scholars Program director stating that you are/were a scholar in good standing with the program.**
- **Copy of your official graduate school acceptance letter**
- **Unofficial Transcript**
